<u>ENTRY FEE</u>	ENTRY FEE IS 50C. PER BIRD. ALL BIRDS ENTERED MUST BE PAID FOR. IF POSTAGE OF STICKERS IS REQUIRED, A CHARGE OF 60C. WILL BE ADDED TO ENTRY FEE.
<u>CAGES</u>	ALL EXHIBITS TO BE STAGED IN RECOGNIZED SHOW CAGES. AT THE DISCRETION OF THE SHOW COMMITTEE, ANY BIRD IN A DIRTY OR BADLY PRESENTED CAGE WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
<u>CLASS LABELS</u>	TO BE FIXED TO RIGHT HAND SIDE BOTTOM CORNER OF CAGE.
<u>FLOOR COVERING</u>	ONE PANDRAMA MILLET SPRAY PER CAGE. Sprays will be available for purchase on the day of the show.
<u>RING NUMBERS</u>	IF PARENT SOCIETY HAS ISSUED C.B.S INC. WITH A CURRENT RING LIST, RING NUMBERS NEED NOT BE DECLARED ON ENTRY FORM. RESPONSIBILITY OF EXHIBITORS TO ENSURE RING LIST HAS BEEN SUPPLIED. SPOT RING CHECKS WILL BE MADE.
<u>YOUNG</u>	MUST BE RING WITH <u>2013</u> CLOSED RING AND MUST BE OWNED AND BRED BY THE EXHIBITOR. SPLIT RINGS ARE NOT PERMITTED.
<u>ANYAGE</u>	BIRDS IN THIS CLASS MUST BE BRED AND OWNED BY THE EXHIBITOR IN THE OPEN, INTERMEDIATE AND NOVICE SECTIONS NO PURCHASED BIRDS CAN BE SHOWN.
<u>STAGING</u>	ALL BIRDS TO BE STAGED BETWEEN 7-30 AND 8-30AM.
<u>JUDGING</u>	TO COMMENCE AT 9-00AM., AND WILL BE TO THE AUSTRALIAN STANDARD.

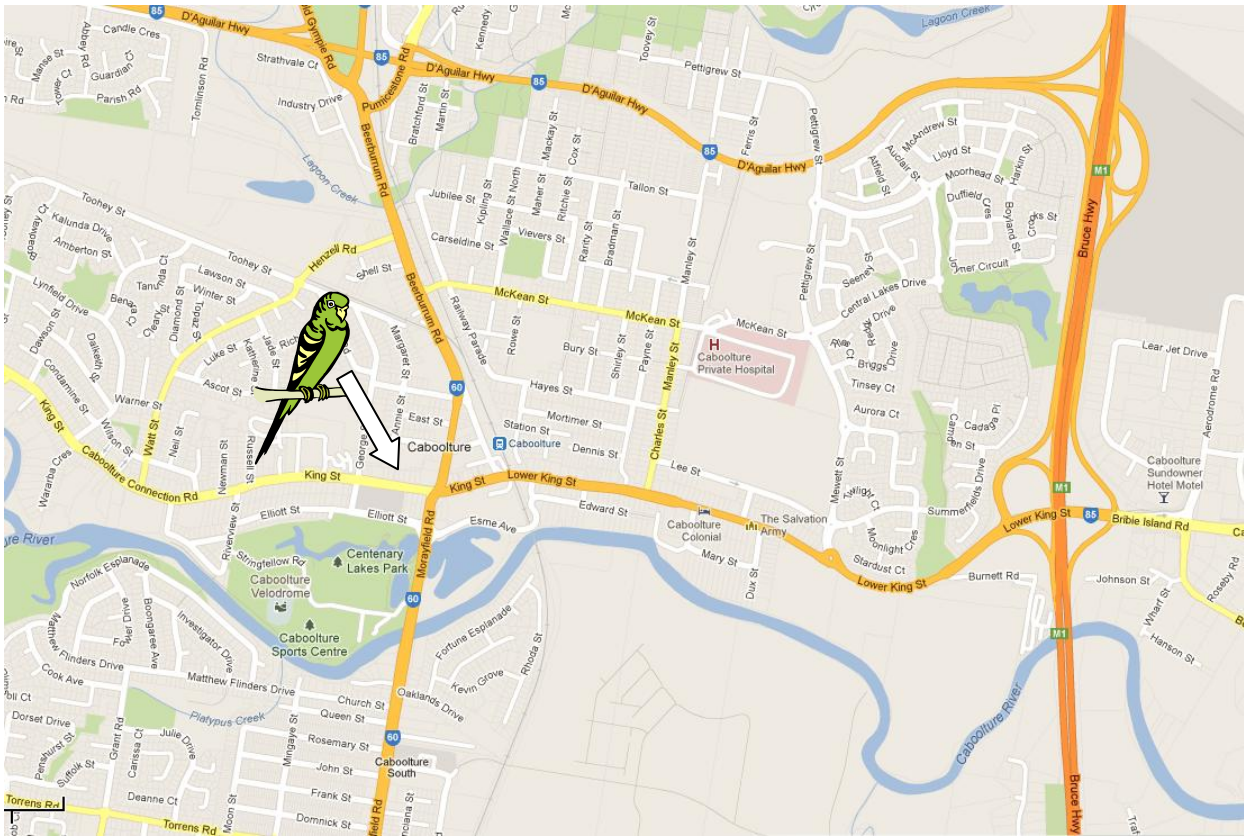

* When placing entries please ensure you state whether Any Age or Young birds are being entered.

* Green Series includes Light, Dark, Olive and Grey Green.

* Blue Series includes Skyblue, Cobalt, Mauve, Violet and Grey.

* All classes are in accordance with the ANBC Standard and Matrix – Amendment 1 of 2012.

* Multiple factor birds exist in many combinations. Therefore, if the schedule does not list a certain colour/variety combination then these birds will go into the AOV and Non Standardised classes. Refer ANBC Standard colour matrix for combinations.

* Any bird carrying multiple factors will only be eligible for awards which can be directly taken by the particular class in which they are entered.

* If you have a bird carrying multiple variety factors, please refer to the colour matrix from the ANBC Standard to see what class you can enter your bird in. For example, if you have a bird that is visually a Dominant Pied, Yellowface, Opaline, Cinnamon and Grey you would check to see the highest section number in the matrix and if all the other factors are included, then that is the class to enter the bird in. In the instance of the bird described, Dominant Pied (sect 16) is the highest, included is Opaline (sect 11), cinnamon (sect 9), Yellowface (sect 3) and grey (sect 2), so therefore in this instance you would enter this particular bird as a Dominant Pied either class 33 or 34 dependant whether a cock or hen.

* Variable class to be nominated on the Show Schedule by each club as required.

USE OF THIS STANDARD - MATRIX

1. For describing Standard Varieties.
2. As a guide and reference for Breeders and Judges.
3. As a guide and reference for exhibitors in ascertaining the classes in which to enter their exhibits.
4. As a guide for compiling show schedules.
5. Combinations of varieties accepted as standard are listed as groups under the primary variety in the combination. Such birds are described as:

..... (primary variety) (other variety) (colour).

Example: Opaline Greywing Yellow Faced Skyblue.

For combinations of more than two varieties to be accepted as standard, every combination of the varieties involved must appear in the groups.

Standard Primary Varieties 11-19 may combine with one or more than one of its group varieties, but will remain the primary variety for exhibition purposes. The largest number listed in the numerical list of sections and combinations is always the primary variety.

NOTE: The "Section Number" is the code number for *The Standard* Primary Variety it represents and includes any birds displaying the Violet Colour Intensity Modifier.
