^{*} If you have a bird carrying multiple variety factors, please refer to the colour matrix from the ANBC Standard to see what class you can enter your bird in. For example, if you have a bird that is visually a Dominant Pied, Yellowface, Opaline, Cinnamon and Grey you would check to see the highest section number in the matrix and if all the other factors are included, then that is the class to enter the bird in. In the instance of the bird described, Dominant Pied (sect 16) is the highest, Yellowface (sect 14) is included, so is Opaline (sect 10), cinnamon (sect 8) and grey (sect 4) is included in yellowface, so therefore is included in this instance. You would enter this particular bird as a Dominant Pied either class 29 or 30 dependant whether a cock or hen.
